The Nina Mason Pulliam Charitable Trust Awards Child Crisis Center \$75,000

The Nina Mason Pulliam Charitable Trust awarded \$1,190,886 in grants to 22 Arizona nonprofit organizations today, including \$75,000 to the Child Crisis Center. The generous grant will help fund the Child Crisis Center's Family Resource Center programs that serve parents and children across the East Valley.

In line with Nina Mason Pulliam Charitable Trust's mission to serve people in need, the Family Resource Center will use this grant to help fund parenting classes, parent support groups, and children's self-development classes. This funding assists the Child Crisis Center in providing these services free to the community. A dedicated funder of the Child Crisis Center's, the Nina Mason Pulliam Charitable Trust is very in-tune to the current needs of the Phoenix-area community. Harriet Ivey, Trust president and CEO asserted that "Helping People in Need has always been the largest funding segment for the Trust. In response to the difficult economic times over the past two years, this area of funding has grown to represent 85 percent of all Trust grantmaking."

The services offered free to the community through this funding will help parents strengthen skills necessary to maintain a strong healthy family during the current stressful economic times.
